

THE FLOOD VICTIM'S BODY

AFTER SEARCH AT PROVIDENCE

FOUND NEAR BRANCH AVE.

Miss Wimpey's Remains Lay Against
a Mass of Brush Close to Post
from Which She Was Swept.

PROVIDENCE, March 12.—After a search lasting through the night, the body of Emily J. Wimpey, the only victim of the bursting of the dams at Randall's Pond, Wanskuck, yesterday afternoon, was recovered at 6 o'clock this morning by two policemen near the place where the woman was swept from the post to which she clung for some time.

The body was found lying against a mass of brush, about 200 feet from Branch avenue, and 500 feet from the place where the freshet cut away that thoroughfare.

It was readily recognized, the face having been bruised but little.

Medical Examiner Perkins viewed the body and gave the cause of death as drowning.
